

Cookies Policy

1. What are cookies?

Cookies are small text files that websites may store on your computer, tablet or mobile device when you visit them.

They can help websites function correctly, remember visitor preferences and provide information about how a website is used.

The WISH website is committed to using cookies and similar technologies transparently and respecting visitors' privacy.

2. What types of cookies may we use?

The following categories describe the cookies that may be relevant to our website. Only categories actually used by the published website will be retained in this policy.

Strictly necessary cookies

These cookies are essential for the website to function correctly.

They may support functions such as website security, navigation, contact form operation or remembering your cookie preferences.

Strictly necessary cookies do not require prior consent where they meet the applicable legal exemption.

Analytics cookies

If enabled, analytics cookies help us understand how visitors use the website, such as which pages are viewed most frequently.

This information can help us improve website accessibility, navigation and content.

Analytics cookies that require consent will only be activated after you give your permission.

Third-party cookies



Some website content, such as embedded videos or other external services, may involve third-party technologies.

Where these technologies require consent, they will not be activated before you have made an appropriate choice.

You can also manage or delete cookies through your browser settings. Disabling certain essential cookies may affect website functionality.

Where applicable, we will provide information about these services and request consent before activating technologies that require it.
